She contributes substantially to pro bono endeavors, working with public policy and criminal defense organizations to provide criminal appellate representation to her clients. She argued for and won, by unanimous consensus, the reversal of her client's manslaughter conviction before New York's highest court, the New York Court of Appeals, establishing important legal precedent in the world of constitutional criminal defense.
